We Know Jean-Baptiste-Marie Vianney as St. John Vianney who had quite the reputation as a "Catholic Rebel." Rebel?! Yes, after being drafted into the French Army in 1809, John deserted and joined other military deserters but granted amnesty in 1810. He was guided by the Holy Spirit and ordained a priest in 1815. He often worked 16-hour days in reconciliation bringing people to God. His fame spread as people traveled to see him, and within 30 years received nearly 20 thousand pilgrims a year. St. John Vianney spoke these words: "Without the Sacrament of Holy Orders, we would not have the Lord. Who put Him there in that tabernacle? The priest. Who welcomed your soul at the beginning of your life? The priest. Who feeds your soul and gives it strength for its journey? The priest. Who will prepare it to appear before God, bathing it one last time in the blood of Jesus Christ? The priest, always the priest. And, if this soul should die as a result of mortal sin, who will raise it up, who will restore its calm and peace? Again, the priest...only in heaven will he fully realize what he is." Fr. John was convinced that the fervor of a priest's life depended entirely upon the Mass." The priest is not a priest for himself, he is a priest for you." So, there is no wonder St. John Vianney was named Patron Saint of Parish Priests! And, with 37 YEARS of priestly ministry this month of June we remember Fr. Larry Jurcak!
