WALK WITH ONE

What is “Walk with One”?

We are all called to evangelize. This may require overcoming some fears—but the Lord is asking each of us to step out of our comfort zone and evangelize one-on-one. There is someone in your life whom Jesus longs to call to Himself. He wants to spark a relationship with them and bless them with His sacraments. This is your opportunity to be God’s instrument in the life of another. Imagine how our country will be transformed if every active Catholic answers this call!

Phase: Connect -Part 1 (Dec. 8- Jan. 5)

Whether you have a person or are still seeking, this prayer may help you to connect to the person Jesus has for you. **Pray:** *“Lord, I’m waiting for you to solve this, to show me the way out, the way forward. I’ve been running, planning, worrying, but now I’m going to let you work. Amen.”* Throughout this phase watch attentively for signs in answer to this prayer. No prayer goes unanswered. Be attentive during holiday gatherings, as you may have opportunities to connect to others with Jesus’ guidance.

Personal Scripture Study

Pray with Luke 5:1-11 placing yourself in the scene. Where are you? What do you see and hear? What is Jesus saying? Reread the passage and place your Walk With One person in the scene. Ask the same questions. How does Jesus look at this person? What is this person doing? Pray this passage often, and occasionally in the Adoration Chapel.

Saint Who Inspires

Saint Thérèse of Lisieux was a “spiritual sister” to several missionaries. Though she never left the monastery, she interceded for the missions through her letters, prayers, and sacrifices. Ask her to give you the grace and courage to speak the truth with love and to express to others the joy of loving Jesus.

Prayer for the New Evangelization

Lord Jesus Christ, you have given your Church the mission to proclaim the Gospel to all the nations. May our efforts to fulfill this mission be guided by the Holy Spirit so that we might be a leaven of new life, salt of the earth and a light to the world—worthy missionaries and faithful to you.

Make us valiant witnesses to the Faith of the Church, and inspire us to speak the truth with love. Help us to communicate to others the joy we have received.

Permit us to be united, but not closed; humble but not fearful; simple, but not naïve; thoughtful, but not overbearing; contemporary, but not superficial; respectful of others, but boldly your disciples.

May we bear into the world the hope of God, which is Christ the Lord, who rose from the dead and lives and reigns with Father and the Holy Spirit, one God forever and ever. Amen.
