#### **Growing in Eucharistic Faith**

Jesus in the Eucharist wants to help you meet the deepest needs of your soul so you can flourish. Each time you receive the Eucharist, Jesus gives you extraordinary gifts to help you live the life you were made for. Some of those fruits and gifts for your soul are friendship with Jesus, desire to know and do the will of God, cleansing of venial sin, hunger for virtue, grace to avoid sin, a heart that listens to the Holy Spirit, and a desire to know and love God. ### Phase: Invite (March 30 - April 27)

Continue to make Lenten sacrifices and pray for your Walk With One person. Invite them to join you for Holy Week services and Easter Sunday. And for yourself, continue to read the book 33 Days to Eucharistic Glory to prepare for the Consecration to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist happening at all Masses the weekend of April 26 & 27.

## **Personal Scripture Study**

Read 1 Corinthians 11:18 -26. Twenty years after Jesus' death and resurrection, St. Paul saw the division in how the people were praying when they gathered together for worship. The people needed a revival! He writes what becomes our first Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass to unite their beliefs with how they lived their lives.

#### Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ, Grant me the grace, wisdom and courage, to live justly, love tenderly and walk humbly with You, my God, all the days of my life. Angels and saints, lead me in the ways of the pilgrim, so that one day I too may share in heaven.

Mary, Mother of Jesus, Teach my soul how to receive your Son in the Eucharist, and how to represent Him in this world. Intercede for me and obtain the grace necessary to allow your Son's teachings to penetrate the darkest, coldest, hardest parts of my heart. Amen.
