VOLUNTEER WAIVER OF CLAIMS

I acknowledge and understand that I am volunteering of my own free will to provide free, volunteer, skilled and/or unskilled labor with respect to a home and/or property project (jointly called the "Community Service Day"). I further acknowledge and understand the Project may contain hazardous substances or conditions to which I may be exposed in the course of my volunteer activities including, but not limited to, lead paint dust and chips (for example, in older layers of paint) or asbestos (for example in shingles, plaster, insulation or flooring), which exposure could be hazardous to my health. Nevertheless, I wish to participate in the Community Service Day as a volunteer ("Volunteer") and am willing to sign this Waiver of Claims as a required condition to participate in the Community Service Day. Therefore, without limiting the generality of the following statement, in consideration of the opportunity to participate in the Community Service Day, I hereby release the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland and St. John Bosco Parish; its directors, officers, agents, representatives, employees and sponsors from all liability, and waive all claims and rights to sue the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland and St. John Bosco Church for any and all injuries, losses, costs, liability, expenses and damages that I might sustain or experience as a result of my participation in the Community Service Day as a volunteer, including, but not limited to, claims resulting from (a) personal injury or death, (b) property damage or destruction, and (c) claims of third parties against me arising from my participation in the Community Service Day as a Volunteer.
