DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

CLEVELAND/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

MONDAY, MAY 10

Depart Cleveland today on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight to France, arriving the following day.

ARRIVE FRANCE/LOURDES

TUESDAY, MAY 11

Your exciting tour begins with your arrival in France. You will be met and escorted to your waiting motorcoach for the drive to the shrine city of Lourdes. It is here where the Virgin Mary appeared in 1858 to a young shepherd girl. (D)

LOURDES

WEDNESDAY, MAY 12

Between February 11 and July 16, 1858, the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl, Bernadette, a total of 18 times. Scratching the ground as instructed by the Virgin, Bernadette saw a miraculous spring well up where none had existed before. Today, Lourdes is the most important shrine to Our Lady. Visit the

Grotto of Apparitions, Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, Basilica of St. Pius X and Way of the Cross over the Hillside. Free time for reflection and devotion. Attend the Blessed Sacrament Procession, the Blessing of the Sick and the famous Torchlight Procession, if taking place. (B,D)

LOURDES/NEVERS

THURSDAY, MAY 13

Drive to Nevers, the final resting place of St. Bernadette. After the 18 apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes, St. Bernadette moved to a convent here and dedicated her life to the sick and to prayer. Spend the night in Nevers. (B,D)

NEVERS/TOURS AREA

FRIDAY, MAY 14

After breakfast visit St. Gildard Convent where Bernadette Soubirous joined the Sisters of Charity and for 13 years lived as Sr. Marie-Bernard. The chapel houses the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. Continue your journey to Tours. Built on the rivers Loire and Cher, Tours is noted for its Cathedral and Archbishop's Palace. Overnight in the Tours area. (B,D)

CHATEAUX COUNTRY

SATURDAY, MAY 15

Today's excursion takes you along the meandering River Cher to the beautiful 16th-century Chateau de Chenonceaux. Enjoy a tour through the handsome rooms known to Catherine de Medici and view the magnificent tapestries and formal gardens. See the imposing fortress-castle Chateau d' Amboise, royal residence of Charles VIII before returning to your hotel in the Tours area. (B)

TOURS AREA/CHARTRES/MONT ST. MICHEL

SUNDAY, MAY 16

The morning takes you to the lovely Loire Valley for Chartres. Visit the magnificent 13th-century Gothic Cathedral, renowned for its soaring towers and stunning stained glass windows -- over 100 windows in all. Drive on to Mont St. Michel, perched on a rocky island in the Gulf of Saint Ma-

lo, on the western edge of Normandy. The remarkable town's 15th century gabled houses and stalls lead skyward to the massive Abbey, the building of which is an impressive architectural accomplishment. (B,D)

MONT ST. MICHEL/NORMANDY/CAEN MONDAY, MAY 17

Your morning walking tour takes you to the town of Mont St. Michel with its medieval abbey. Afterwards, drive to Normandy and Omaha Beach, where Allied troops stormed ashore to launch the D-Day invasion. See the American Military Cemetery and Monument before ending your day in Caen. (B,D)

CAEN/LISIEUX/PARIS

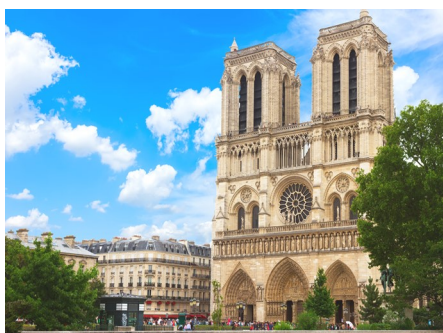
TUESDAY, MAY 18

Your pilgrimage takes you to Lisieux to visit Les Buissonnets, home to St. Therese, the Little Flower. Tour the Carmelite convent and chapel, the 12th century Cathedral of St. Pierre and the Basilica of St. Therese housing her remains. Afterwards, journey to Paris, the "City of Light". (B)

PARIS

WEDNESDAY, MAY 19

Your morning tour of Paris will include many of the famous landmarks recognized throughout the world such as the Opera House, the Madeleine Church, the Place de la Concorde, the Champs Elysees, Napoleon's great Arc de Triomphe, Les Invalides, the Military Academy and the Eiffel Tower. Visit the impressive Notre Dame Cathedral before enjoying free time in Paris to explore this vibrant city on your own. (B)

THURSDAY, MAY 20

Enjoy a full day at leisure to further explore this famously beautiful city on your own. Stroll along the Champs-Elysees, perhaps do some last-minute shopping, visit the world-renowned Louvre, or relax at a Parisian Café. The day is yours to experience one of Europe's greatest treasures. (B)
